- Fees required by Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) from RM3,400 - RM3,550 (For Processing fee, Medical Screening, Insurance, Multiple Visa and ID Card) depending on the country is chargeable separately from the Tuition Fee.
- A Security Bond Fee, ranging from RM200 to RM2000 depending on nationality, is imposed by Immigration Malaysia. This fee is refundable, provided that all outstanding payments are cleared and the Student Pass cancellation is completed in compliance with the required procedures.
- The Application Fee & Registration Fee are STRICTLY NON-TRANSFERABLE AND NON-REFUNDABLE once the offer has been accepted.
- First year Tuition Fee payments made are NON-REFUNDABLE except if the student visa is refused by EMGS/Immigration. All Fees paid are NON-REFUNDABLE under any circumstances once the visa is approved or after the student has commenced studies at any level, including intensive English, Diploma, Certificate, Foundation Programmes and Bachelor's Degree Programmes. This includes students who do not qualify for enrolment into the course approved in the Visa Approval letter (VAL) due to not achieving the required English competency.
- The 1st year fees must be paid BEFORE students arrive in Malaysia. Failing to do so, students would have to return to their home country.
- Any scholarships or bursaries are only applicable if the student completes the programme with UM-Wales.
- All fees are payable in Malaysian Ringgit (RM). Any shortfall arising from foreign exchange currency transaction to Ringgit Malaysia and bank charges will be borne by the students.
- Post-dated cheques are not accepted.
- The Dual Award fee for a UK degree is RM18,000. The fee will be charged by semester - RM3,600 for the first 5 semesters. This fee does not include the optional mobility programme to UWTSO.
- Students who intend to sign up in the Dual Award program must complete their registration prior to the commencement of the first semester. Please note that once registered, withdrawal will not result in a fee release. The fees will remain applicable and non-refundable under all circumstances.
- The Mobility Programme fee is RM 21,000 and required to be fully settled during the first year of studies, prior to departure to UWTSO. This program is exclusively available to Dual Award students as an optional opportunity for academic mobility.
- A Resource and Extension Fee will be applicable for each additional semester that exceeds the duration outlined in the approved program structure. This fee is implemented to support continued access to institutional resources and services beyond the standard program timeline.
- For Credit Transfer Exemptions (CTE), a fee of RM100 - RM200 will be charged for

- processing. CTE Fee will be different than the original fee.
- If student register in additional module beyond the standard curriculum, additional fee will be applied.
- An additional Resource Fee of RM600 per semester will be imposed on students enrolled in the Part-Time mode program starting from the 10th semester onward. This fee is implemented to ensure continued access to institutional resources and support services for extended program durations.
